Bio

The David Brown Cover Band (DBCBC) is an offshoot of the rock meets jazz original act Threepiece, formed by old friends in 2000. Peggy Mitchell at WFSS described the trio as having "evolving music and matchless musicianship. (2004)" Peter McArthur (guitar, bagpipes, vocals), Sean Rooney (bass), and Josh Walters (drums, vocals) met David Brown (guitar, vocals) in Downtown Fayetteville during the fall of 2003 where Threepiece regularly performed. What started in 2004 has now grown to include at least 6 hours of music, professional sound equipment, lighting gear, and a trailer. All aimed at filling a rock and roll niche in the regional cover band market.

In the fall of 2004, DBCBC began hosting the Open Mic Night every Wednesday at local favorite, Big Harry's Tavern; constantly playing new material with complete strangers in styles ranging from alternative rock, to blues, jazz to classic rock, including even back to back rap and country. Since then, they have played festivals, birthday's, sporting events, weddings, and private parties while still performing in regular rotation at bars, clubs, and restaurants throughout North Carolina. This totals to well over 90 events in their first year of existence.

Most notably, DBCBC performed at Fayetteville's 2005 Dogwood Festival, which attracts tens of thousands, as well as the Crown Coliseum for the Fayetteville Guard, an arena football team. There they provided the pre/post-game entertainment as well as the halftime show. DBCBC has also performed for the Fort Bragg group USOSOC, at their family day event by Smith Lake.
